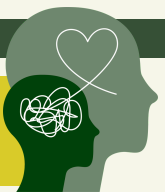

 - 5 military community members



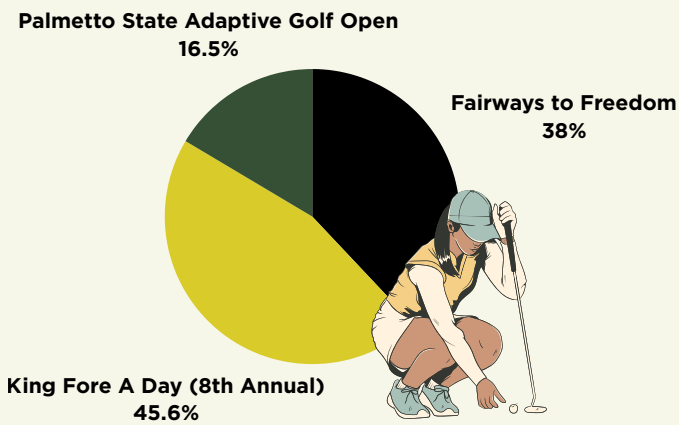
